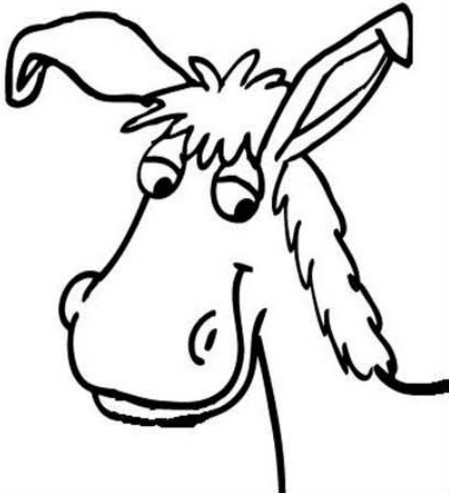

(During the Gladwin Carriage Festival)

The goal is to gain the knowledge to improve your working relationship with your donkey / mule. Spectators are welcome, participants must register in advance.

*\*Participants will be required to bring helmet, leather gloves, boots, and supplies to care for their mule / donkey.*

**Spectators welcome: \$2 admission to fairgrounds for all spectators, no additional fee for spectators!**

**Clinic: Saturday, August 13 (9am—5pm) & Sunday, August 14 (9am—12 pm)**

*Participants with mule / donkey: 2 day clinic is \$200 if payment postmarked by June 1, \$250 if postmarked after June 1. Late registration must be received by July 25. Camping is available on site (\$25 for the weekend). Stalls are also available (\$20 for the weekend) Advance registration is required for clinic, camping and stalls.*

**\*Negative Coggins (must have been drawn in past 12 months) required for all mules/donkeys**
